



Cherokee-BlueRidgePky-ChimneyRock-Franklin

There is no gas available on the BRP. It's best to top-off in Cherokee. US 74-A has lots of gas stations just after you leave the BRP. Hwy 64 from Chimney Rock to Highlands has lots of gas stations, as does Hwy 28 into and out of Franklin.

Warnings:

It's best to try and plan your time so that you don't come through Hendersonville and Brevard during rush hour. Sometimes, it's just not possible to do this, but the rush hour traffic in those areas is annoying. Additional Recommendations:

- Always bring raingear. The weather in this part of the country can go from "absolutely beautiful" to "monsoon" in a matter of minutes.
- If you're riding the Blue Ridge Parkway, bring some additional clothing. At the highest parts of the BRP, the temperature can sometimes be as much as 30 degrees cooler than at lower elevations.
